9. Am I enjoying prayer?
10. When did I last speak to someone else about my faith?
11. Do I pray about the money I spend?
12. Do I get to bed on time and get up on time?
13. Do I disobey God in anything?
14. Do I insist upon doing something about which my conscience is uneasy?
15. Am I defeated in any part of my life?
16. Am I jealous, immoral, critical, irritable, touchy, or distrustful?
17. How do I spend my spare time?
18. Am I prideful?
19. Do I thank God that I am not as bad as certain people?
20. Is there anyone whom I fear, dislike, disown, criticize, hold a resentment toward or disregard? If so, what am I doing about it?
21. Do I grumble or complain constantly?
22. Is Christ real to me?

Mark 1:21-28 (NLT) ²¹ Jesus and his companions went to the town of Capernaum. When the Sabbath day came, he went into the synagogue and began to teach. ²² The people were amazed at his teaching, for he taught with real authority—quite unlike the teachers of religious law. ²³ Suddenly, a man in the synagogue who was possessed by an evil-spirit began shouting, ²⁴ “Why are you interfering with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!” ²⁵ Jesus cut him short. “Be quiet! Come out of the man,” he ordered. ²⁶ At that, the evil spirit screamed, threw the man into a convulsion, and then came out of him. ²⁷ Amazement gripped the audience, and they began to discuss what had happened. “What sort of new teaching is this?” they asked excitedly. “It has such authority! Even evil spirits obey his orders!” ²⁸ The news about Jesus spread quickly throughout the entire region of Galilee.

Marcos 1:21-28 (NVI) ²¹ Entraron en Capernaúm, y tan pronto como llegó el *sábado, Jesús fue a la sinagoga y se puso a enseñar.²² La gente se asombraba de su enseñanza, porque la impartía como quien tiene autoridad y no como los *maestros de la ley.²³ De repente, en la sinagoga, un hombre que estaba poseído por un *espíritu maligno gritó: ²⁴ —¿Por qué te entrometes, Jesús de Nazaret? ¿Has venido a destruirnos? Yo sé quién eres tú: ¡el Santo de Dios! ²⁵ —¡Cállate! —lo reprendió Jesús—. ¡Sal de ese hombre! ²⁶ Entonces el espíritu maligno sacudió al hombre violentamente y salió de él dando un alarido.²⁷ Todos se quedaron tan asustados que se preguntaban unos a otros: «¿Qué es esto? ¡Una enseñanza nueva, pues lo hace con autoridad! Les da órdenes incluso a los espíritus malignos, y le obedecen.»²⁸ Como resultado, su fama se extendió rápidamente por toda la región de Galilea.
